

Construction Activity for July 26 – August 1, 2010

Downtown Pipeline Replacement Project

The Downtown project continues on schedule.

Pipe installation continues on N. Florida Avenue, Cass Street, Tampa Street, Polk Street, and Twiggs Street. Connections begin on Nebraska, Zack, Twiggs, and Jefferson.

Road closures and detours:

- Florida Avenue (Harrison to Scott): Two easternmost travel lanes closed from 5AM to 3PM. Two northbound travel lanes open after 3PM.
- Laurel Street (Florida to Marion): Closed to through traffic.
- Fortune Street (Florida to Marion): Closed to through traffic.
- Harrison Street (Franklin to Marion): Closed to traffic.
- Tyler Street (Ashley to Franklin): Closed to through traffic.
- Cass Street (Jefferson to Governor): Eastbound travel lane closed. One westbound travel lane remains open for local traffic only.
- Cass Street (Governor to Nebraska): One westbound and one eastbound travel lane remain open for local traffic only.
- Cass Street (Tampa to Florida): Northernmost eastbound travel lane closed.
- Polk Street (Jefferson to Ashley): Northern westbound travel and parking lanes are closed.
- Twiggs Street (Florida to Pierce): Northernmost westbound travel and parking lanes are closed. Two eastbound travel lanes remain open.
- Twiggs Street (at Meridian): The two southernmost traffic lanes and the Selmon Expressway Reversible Elevated Lane southbound right turn lane exit at Twiggs Street closed Tuesday July 27 9:30AM to Wednesday July 28 5:30AM. One eastbound lane and one westbound lane on Twiggs will be maintained in the two northernmost traffic lanes.
- Marion Street (Cass to Polk): Closed to through traffic.
- Marion Street (Zack to Twiggs): Closed to through traffic.
- Tampa Street (Twiggs to Jackson): Westernmost travel and parking lanes are closed. Two easternmost travel lanes remain open.
- Jefferson Street (Zack to Twiggs): Two southbound lanes closed. Open for local access only. Two northbound lanes remain open to traffic.
- Kennedy Boulevard (at Tampa): Two northernmost lanes closed from July 23 6PM to July 26 5AM.

Please allow for extra time to get to your destination! Many downtown area roads have lane closures or different traffic patterns due to UCAP and other City of Tampa construction activities.
